Commenting on the plans announced today by C40 Chair and Mayor of Paris, Anne Hidalgo, and Mayor of London, Sadiq Khan, to tackle air pollution in their cities, **Paul Wilson, chief** executive officer of the World Platinum Investment Council (WPIC) said:

"WPIC is very encouraged by the leadership being shown by London and Paris on the issue of air quality in cities. Independent road-testing provides an excellent starting point as consumers and policy makers consider the wide range of emissions performance from different cars and make appropriate choices.

"This approach is groundbreaking as it will provide consumers with independent modelby-model emissions data and it also sends a strong signal to car makers.

"As platinum has long played a critical role in emissions control solutions, we understand the technical capabilities of the automotive industry well. We are keen to contribute to a dialogue rooted in fact and focussed on proactive action. Our analysis and test results from Emissions Analytics¹ show that best-in-class technologies which already achieve Euro 6c NOx limits on-the-road were installed on some models sold in 2016. We now need to tip the scales so that this is the case for the many, not the few. We would urge the car makers to recognise the vital, proactive role they can play in a viable solution to the air quality issue."
